

May Pole Information

Over the past several years the price of the May Pole dresses has risen considerably. In an attempt to keep the price down and May Pole participation up, we have decided to try something different this year.

We will have sign up for May Pole during January. If you are going to participate in May Pole,

you will need to complete a registration form and an extra curricular code of conduct at that time.

Practice dates and times will be set at that time. All practices are mandatory!

In addition to this, you will be responsible for getting your own dress and having it approved prior to March 1.

Your dress must abide by the following guidelines:

1. It may be any solid color.
2. It may be floor length or tea length
(Tea-length is just below the knee - three or four inches above the ankle).
3. It may not be strapless.
4. It may not be low cut.
5. It may not have any midriff or back cut outs.
6. It must be approved by Mrs. Miller or Mrs. Fritch. We ask that you try your dress on for us, so that we can make sure that the above criteria is followed. You will have to see us before or after school. We reserve the right to refuse a dress or request that alterations be made. The dress that is approved is the one that you are required to wear during May Fete. Otherwise, we will not wind.

After all of the dresses have been approved, Mrs. Miller and Mrs. Fritch will determine shoe color and streamer color to coordinate and compliment the chosen dresses.
